Stone Age to Iron Age



English

Key Texts: The Tunnel by Anthony Browne and The Iron Man by Ted Hughes

Reading: We will continue to develop our comprehension skills through a variety of texts.

Writing:

Take One Book: An alternative ending to the story.

Take One Book: Setting description.

Within these units the children will continue to develop their understanding of the different parts of a sentence. These include noun, adjectives, verbs, capitals and full stops. They will also begin to learn about paragraphs and how to use them in their writing.
